

CHARTER ORDINANCE C-1

To Change the Terms of Office of
Members of the Village Board

The Village Board of Oconomowoc Lake do ordain as follows:

Pursuant to Sections 61.195 and 66.01 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the Village of Oconomowoc Lake elects not to be governed by those portions of Section 61.20 relating to the tenure of the Village trustees and hereby specifies that there shall be six (6) trustees of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, three (3) of whom shall be elected at each regular spring election in odd-numbered years for a term of four (4) years commencing on the third Tuesday of April in the year of their election; provided, that the three (3) trustees to be elected at the April 1960 election shall be elected for a term of three (3) years.

Passed and adopted by a vote of two-thirds of the Village Board of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake, Waukesha County, Wisconsin, this 5th day of November, 1959.
