There was no one in attendance other than those noted above.

An ordinance to repeal and re-create Section 17.19(3)(d) entitled "Signs in Residence Districts of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake"

Mr. Kneiser explained that the current ordinance allows for one "for sale" sign per property. Current practice is to have one "for sale" sign at the curb side of the property and one at the lake side. The proposed ordinance allows for two "for sale" signs on all properties in the Village.

An ordinance to repeal and re-create Section 17.81 entitled "Penalties of the Village of Oconomowoc Lake Zoning Code"

Mr. Kneiser explained that the current ordinance imposes negligible penalties for violations of the zoning code. The revision imposes penalties of not less than \$500 nor more than \$2,000 per day plus costs of prosecution for each violation of the zoning code. The intent is to encourage better compliance with the zoning code.
